EXTENSIONS OF SICK PAY

Purpose of Report

1. To inform Members of the decisions taken by the Chief Fire Officer following consultation with the Chairman in respect of the granting of extensions of sick pay.

Background

- **2.** Since the Executive Panel's meeting on 15th November 2007, four extensions of sick pay have been granted.
- 3. In one case the entitlement to six months full pay had expired followed by a further six months of pay at 100% of full pay. An extension of pay at 100% of full pay has been granted for a period of six months while treatment is progressing.
- 4. In one case the entitlement to six months full pay had expired and an extension of pay at 100% of full pay has been granted for a period of six months or a return to work, whichever is the sooner.
- 5. In one case the entitlement to six months full pay had expired followed by a further six months of pay at 100% of full pay. An extension of pay at 50% of full pay has been granted for a period of six months or a return to work, whichever is the sooner.



Background (continued)

- **6.** In one case the entitlement to six months full pay had expired followed by a further four months of pay at 100% of full pay. An extension of pay at 50% of full pay has been granted for a period of six months or a return to work, whichever is the sooner.
- **7.** In the period under review, two employees are Wholetime and two are Retained members within the Service.
